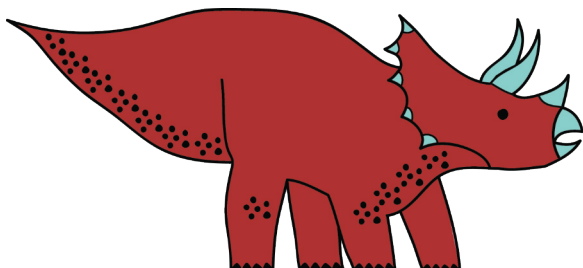
The Children's Cancer and Leukaemia Group (CCLG) are responsible for valuable research behind treatment for childhood cancers like Rory's and the advancement of our understanding of the disease. Alongside this, CCLG provide loads of helpful information for the whole family with regards to specific cancers and what the treatment process might look like. Any donations to Rory's CCLG fund will go towards researching medulloblastoma.



The Grand Appeal have been the funding force behind most of Rory's treatment, especially the equipment that made his brain surgery so advanced, successful and, most importantly, safe. They do amazing things to support both patients and families in Bristol Children's Hospital. They fund everything from tea and coffee for families to state-of-the-art surgical equipment to arts programmes and Reiki sessions to vital support for bereaved families. Any money raised through Rory's Grand Appeal fund will be split between neurosurgery and oncology.



CLIC Sargent have been present since the very beginning of Rory's diagnosis and continue to help us find our way through the process as parents, including sourcing grant funding to make up for lost earnings and providing nursing care at home to reduce trips to hospital.
